DID YOU KNOW?

HSG students transformed a staircase leading up from St. Gallen city centre to the university into a climate diagram: Each step represents a year and shows with colours how temperatures are rising in Switzerland. This Climate Staircase (see picture on the last page of this bulletin) is intended to raise awareness of climate change. Each step of this Climate Staircase stands for a year and shows to what extent the average temperature in Switzerland has deviated downwards (blue) or upwards (red).
