GENERAL TECHNICAL MEETING

Mr Matjaz Pecovnik (EUSA Secretary General) opened the GTM with much charm. Mr Daniel Studer (Chairman of the Organisation Committee) informed about EUOC's organisation where 186 athletes from 66 universities from 17 European countries will participate in the presence of 18 officials. Mr Dusan Vystavel (EUSA Technical Delegate) and Mr Jürg Hellmüller (Technical Director of the Organisation Committee) explained the sports technical matters. Ms Eszter Gulyas (EUSA representative) pointed out the important Enno Fair Play Award embedded in the EUSA statutes has the objective to encourage and support the promotion of ethics, fair play, gender equity and good governance in sport as well as education of university students through sport. The Enno Harms Fair Play Award is an annual prize which takes into account a fair play gesture or situation during a EUSA sporting event which stands out above the rest.
